**Fullblood Boer Bucks**

**Placing: 1-3-2-4**

**Cuts: 2-2-2**

I am placing this class of 0-3 month buck kids 1-3-2-4

I am starting this class with 1 who is very upstanding, level across the top, showing good length of body with proper placement of the legs at the corners of the body. He is wide in the chest and it follows all the way to his rump. This young buck shows good angulation to the rear legs as viewed from the side with much muscle thickness down to the knee than the other three.

3 places over 2 for his levelness in the chine, the extra width in the chest, with more mass of bone. He also has a longer neck blending smoothly into the withers than 2. He shows definition of muscling of rear leg than 2 with a longer rump.

2 places over 4 for the proper levelness in the chine, correctness in rear leg angulations, and standing on a stronger foreleg than 4. 2 will have to grant length of body to 4.

4 is to be commended for that length of body and width throughout, but is found lacking in rear leg angulation, straightness of foreleg, flatness across the chine, and levelness of rump from thurl to thurl.
