

Black Terminal Boars Video Clips Dec. 2008

Placing: 4-1-3-2

Cuts: 2-3-4

I placed the class of Black Terminal Boars 4-1-3-2. I started with 4 as he best combined muscle, structure and balance. More specifically he was the widest based boar who stood down on a bigger foot and heel. He too possessed more muscle in lower, center and upper portions of his ham. Additionally he was more pulled apart about his blades and stood down more correctly on his front feet. I realize that 1 is more sensibly sized but he is more structurally incorrect being pigeon toed and incorrect in his angulation off of his rear legs.

Even so in my middle pair of boars, it is meat animal shape and width that places 1 over 3. 1 is a wider designed boar being wider through his chest floor and width of base. Furthermore he is stronger on his front pasterns and has more meat animal shape being stouter out through his hip and possesses a larger loin eye area. I admit that 3 is a deeper sided boar but it ends there as he is weaker on his front pasterns, narrower made and lighter muscled.

In my concluding pair it is balance, structure and muscle that places 3 over 2. The narrow belted boar has more muscle expression when viewed from behind and down his top. He too is wider based and a deeper sided boar. On the other hand, 2 is the levelest designed boar with the highest tail setting, yet he also is the lightest muscled and shallowest made boar of the class.
