

Boer Doelings Jan. 2009

Placing: 3-1-4-2

Cuts: 4-2-6

I placed the class of Boer Doelings 3-1-4-2. I started the class off with 3 because of her power, balance, and femininity. She excels in length from flank to flank, as well as from hooks to pins. The most expressively muscled doe as evident from her forearm to withers, and from her stifle to rump. I would like to see less protrusion of her brisket and give her a higher neck attachment. Granted 1 is the smoothest, most striking doe in the class, she does not possess the power and overall length of body to move up.

In my middle pair I placed 1 over 4. 1 has more extension in her front end and is smoother out through her chest floor than 4. She is stronger and bolder in her heart girth and rib shape, and wedges nicely towards the rear. For her bone size and framework she has adequate length. I would like to power her up a bit and make her longer in her rump. I agree that 4 has more capacity and length, but she doesn't present it in a nice complete balanced package.

In my bottom pair I placed 4 over 2 as she is more correct in her structure and better balanced than 2. She is longer fronted, exhibits a smoother neck attachment, and is stronger in her top line than 2. I would like to see more muscle expression and make her more feminine through her front end. Even though 2 is longer from flank to flank, stouter in her bone work, and more capacious than 4, she is early maturing, heavy fronted, deep sided, weaker top, and down on her pasterns.
