How Scoring Works

- Class of 4 animals
- Rank from most desirable to least desirable (**placing**)
- Each placing has **three pairs**
 - Top, middle, bottom

How Scoring Works

- Each pair is assigned a cut
 - Assigned by the officials
 - Based on difficulty of placing
 - 1 - difficult placing
 - 3 - challenging, but can be found
 - 5 - easy
 - 7 - extremely easy
- The total cuts **cannot add to more than 15**

How Scoring Works

- The cut equals points lost, if the placing is missed.
- Easiest way to learn is to work through examples.

Examples

Official: 1 2 3 4

Cuts: 2 5 3

Your Placing: 2 1 3 4

Type: pair switch

Score: 48

Examples

Official: 1 2 3 4
Cuts: 2 5 3
Your Placing: 2 3 1 4
Type: simple bust

Score: 41

Examples

Official: 1 2 3 4

Cuts: 2 5 3

Your Placing: 4 3 2 1

Type: complex bust

Score: 15
